### Nature Notes

June 27th A male great spotted woodpecker brought two young ones to peck into a mossy area of our lawn this morning. They seemed to be finding some grubs and at the same time pecking out some of the moss. June 29th I was lucky enough to see a hare cross the road near the Elm crossroads this morning.

July 7th Everything seems to be blooming exceptionally well this year so perhaps last years weather suited the flowers.

July 11th I saw a red kite flying over Tadmarton today. I was shown 2 scarlet tiger moths and have since heard of another one being seen. My book says that they like streams and moist meadows so Sibford will not suit them at the moment.

July 12th I would think the young blackbird that I found dead on our lawn today was not more than a week old. Hopefully it was one that had died in the nest and had been removed and dropped there and was not from a nest that had been raided by a predator.

July 13th We have found the shells of several pheasants eggs around the garden recently. I wonder whether a fox has found a deserted nest and is carrying them away.

July 14th There seem to be more swifts around than at this time last year. I think there were a dozen or more racing round the buildings at



### Wild about plants?

Wild plant charity <u>Plantlife</u> are hoping to reach out to many wild plant enthusiasts and nature lovers by inviting them to become wild plant *pioneers* and subscribe to a free quarterly e-learning bulletin to learn more about our native wild plants via the <u>Wild About Plants project website</u>. The May e-bulletin is out now and the August issue being written as we speak!

The Wild About Plants team deliver Plantlife's outreach programme and work to help people reconnect with the outdoors and their local greenspaces. Working with schools, families and communities from all walks of life and with fantastic free downloadable resources, the team hope to engage people with the nature on their doorstep. In recent years subscribers have been asked to record the plant life in their local area and recount what they used to see/pick and forage for.

Plantlife have just launched *Flowers on the Edge*, their annual road-verges campaign. They are asking communities to record how their road verges are looking this summer by taking photos and sending in stories

Wild About Plants is funded by Natural England through Access to Nature, as part of the Big Lottery Fund's Changing Spaces programme. It is a partnership project involving partner organisations throughout the country.
