#### Nature Notes

Dec 15th The redwings and blackbirds have already stripped the berries from our holly tree. The redwings have mostly moved on as there are quite a lot of well berried holly trees still around and the blackbirds are now taking the yellow pyracantha berries. Our holly berries are always taken very early which may mean that they are the most palatable variety or that the tree is in a quieter position with less disturbance than most. Dec 31st I could see that a female bullfinch that came close to the window had a white covering over a foot and lower leg which seemed to be uncomfortable. I don't know whether it is diseased or whether it has trodden in something.

Jan 1st My measurement of the rainfall for 2013 was an above average 31.84 inches (809mm). The driest months were June with 1.18 inches (30mm) and April 1.2 inches (31mm). The wettest by far was October with 5.62 inches (143mm). The first half of December was very dry but in the month from December 16th to January 15th this year, I measured 8.17 inches (208mm) no wonder the ground is sodden.

Jan 4th A male bullfinch died when it crashed into one of our windows this morning.

Jan 10th A male blackcap was feeding on our fallen apples this morning and two nuthatches came to feed at the same time. It is always difficult to know how many there are as they tend to come singly and go away

quickly with a sunflower heart. There were between four and five hundred fieldfares on the junior playing field at the Friends School today which is the biggest flock that I have seen this winter.

Jan 12th There were 5 female and 4 male bullfinches at our feeders today. They have really developed a taste for sunflower hearts. A few years ago we usually saw them feeding on the seeds of stinging nettles and ignoring what was going on on the bird table only a few yards away. When I went out on this fine frosty morning a great spotted woodpecker was drumming in our beech tree and another one answering from a few hundred yards away, a mistle thrush in full song and a robin singing. A song thrush also sang but not yet it's 'full rollicking song' as the diarist Joseph Woodruff might have said.

Jan 15th The male blackbird that we saw last winter that only has a half length upper mandible is feeding here again. I expect it has been around for the whole year but it only comes close enough to recognise in the winter. It looks well in spite of it's damage or deformity and does not seem to have much difficulty feeding.

Jan 18th A female blackcap put in an appearance today.

Jan 20th We have not seen a muntjac recently although I expect they are around nightly but one was eating our fallen apples this morning. Jan 21st I have always thought of bullfinches as birds usually seen singly, in pairs or sometimes, in late summer, as family groups but certainly not an upland bird. My old birdbook says that they are 'secretive seldom leaving cover' so I was surprised to see on the TV programme

# Fed up with poor mobile phone reception?

Poor mobile phone reception is a problem for many in the villages. The Sibfords Community Plan household questionnaire indicated wide spread dissatisfaction, only 30% of respondents graded their mobile phone service as satisfactory. We now have an opportunity to do something about this situation. The Countryside Alliance (CA) is organising a "project to map rural mobile phone signals", they are looking for "evidence to ensure people living in the countryside are not forgotten by mobile phone companies and that they benefit from the Government's £150m mobile phone infrastructure project." You can help this project by providing mobile signal data from our villages. (At the time of writing data from our community is sparse). 

# Sibford WI Report - Meeting 14th January 2014

President Glennis Hardman welcomed Members and five guests, Diana Hughes, Angela Boswell, Linda Obertelli-Roden, Mary Mills and Mary West. Secretary Lynda Conway gave a full report of the December Meeting when we combined our Christmas Party with the celebration of Sibford WI's 85th Anniversary. Glennis thanked the entertainers, Rosemary and Peter Neil and Peter Hardman, Lynda for the making of a special cake and all those who contributed to the serving of a sumptuous buffet tea.

This months speaker, Helen Phillips, entertained us with a talk about the history and production of Pashmina shawls and then gave us the opportunity to browse and purchase a lovely selection of shawls and other goods produced in Kashmir.

Helen told us of her journeys into Kashmir which is an area of conflict and a melting pot of different religions. Pashminas started out as an item worn by men around their waist or as turban but during the eighteenth century they appeared in the west as gifts for ladies. Napoleon's Josephine had a collection of 400! True Pashminas are made using the wool from the underbelly of a particular breed of goat found in the uplands of Kashmir. A master craftsman can take up to two and a half years to complete a finely embroidered shawl. Hand looms and hand block patterns are used. Videos were used to demonstrate the various processes. It is a dying trade as most of the experts are old men, the young are not so interested. Helen also told us of her work on a variety of projects in the region to increase employment and improve education.

This was a fascinating insight into a special part of India. Its way of life and the work of its master craftsmen. The speaker was thanked by Jan Warner.

Val Powell and Eleanor Joynes served tea with a selection of delicious cakes. The many entries for the compeition "A Pashmina type Shawl" gave the judging by the speaker a difficult task. After some consideration, she chose 1st Jan Warner, 2nd Glennis Hardman and 3rd Valerie Taylor.

Tuesday, 11th February, is the date of our next Meeting. Mark Billen will be with us to give a talk on "Creating Books for Children". The competition will be "A Teddy Bear". Guests most welcome - Village Hall, 2pm.




# Talented Youngsters picked for support programme


