HOLY TRINITY CHURCH PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION - RULES OF ENTRY

BACKGROUND

We, the Parochial Church Council of Holy Trinity Church, Sibford Gower, a Charity registered with the Charity Commissioners, are planning to raise funds for Holy Trinity Church. Winners of this competition will have their photos printed in the form of a calendar and sold as a means to raise funds.

The photographs will be independently judged by experienced local photographers and the twelve chosen photographs will be printed and exhibited in Sibford church on 8th October 2022 when visitors will be able to vote for *The People's Choice*. The winner of this vote will receive Lunch at the Wykham Arms.

All photographs entered will be digitally displayed in the church as part of the exhibition.

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to:



Residents of Sibford Ferris, Sibford Gower and Burdrip and also those who live elsewhere but are members of Sibford village societies and organisations



Children (or parents of children) attending Sibford Endowed Primary School or Sibford School.



There are no age limits (except for the entry ofr August



Photographs must not have been printed as part of the 2022 Church calendar.

Children, 16 and under may enter a special section reserved for them and the winner will be printed for the month of August. A special prize of £20 will be awarded to the winning entry.

HOW TO ENTER

All images entered must: be a colour image, in landscape format. NOT be a close-up or macro shot Be in sufficient resolution for high quality printing at A5 size; a photo taken on a modern smartphone will usually be good enough.

Entries should be submitted as digital images via email to: photocomp@thesibfords.uk on or before 10 September 2022. We cannot accept postal entries. No more than 10 images may be submitted per person. If more than 10 images per person are received, such entries may be deemed void and such entrant may be disqualified from the competition.

JUDGING

All valid entries will be judged to see which image is the most visually appealing interpretation of the competition theme. The winners will be chosen by experienced independent judges. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

The competition theme is The Spirit of the Sibfords.
