OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SIBFORD FERRIS PARISH) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20**

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Sibford Ferris Parish) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 202*.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes
- 4. The Oxfordshire County Council (Sibford Ferris Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 2003 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

20mph speed limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Sibford Ferris extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	The unnamed road running northwards to Burdrop Hawkes Lane	a point 143 metres north of its junction with Mannings Close.
b)	Hook Norton Road	a point <mark>150 220</mark> metres south of its junction with Cotswold Close.
c)	Main Street	a point 125 metres east of its junction with Folly Court.
d)	Woodway Road	a point 169 metres southwest of its junction with Hook Norton Road.
