OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SIBFORD GOWER PARISH) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20**

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 282, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Sibford Gower Parish) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 202*.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes
- 4. The Oxfordshire County Council (Sibford Gower Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 2003 is hereby revoked.

20mph speed limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Sibford Gower extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points: -

a)	Colony Road	a point 675 105 metres southwest northeast of its junction with Barley Close Bridleway No.348/2/20
b)	Hawkes Lane (northern end)	a point <mark>165 155</mark> metres north of its junction with Acre Ditch
c)	The unnamed road running southwards to Sibford Ferris Hawkes Lane (southern end)	a point <mark>163 155</mark> metres south of its junction with Acre Ditch <mark>/Hawke's Lane</mark>

d)	Pound Lane	a point 204 195 metres north of its junction with
		High Meadow.
