Annual Parish Meeting

Notes of the meeting held on Thursday 29th May @ 7pm in Sibford Village Hall

Present - Cllr J Noquet (Parish Council Chairman), 9 members of the public.

- Cllr J Noquet advised that the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council had not been able to go ahead as no agenda had been prepared but the Parish Council (PC) will try to hold it as soon as possible.
- Oswyn Murray presented a very useful report from the Town Estates Charity (TEC). A copy will appear in the next Sibford Scene and a copy will be available on the SGPC notice board. SGPC will confirm that T Morby and B Heather will stand as members of the TEC for a further 4 year term. Oswyn Murray confirmed that he will step down from his role as Chair shortly having served the TEC for 2 terms and some. The TEC reminded the PC that they have funds available for residents of Sibford Gower and Burdrop. Anyone requiring assistance can apply in confidence to the TEC on sibfordtec@gmail.com. Examples of how the TEC have distributed funds under their Relief in Need scheme are included in their report.
- The Sibford Gower Primary School celebrates 400 years this year and the PC will liaise with the TEC to see if anything can be done to assist with some sort of celebration.
- Cllr J Noquet will arrange to meet with Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) Highways Engagement Team to discuss the parking near the pond. Some keep clear road markings are faded and no longer effective.
- The PC will invite Chris Brant - our local county councillor - to the next meeting to discuss potholes, gully emptying and road surfaces within the village. Cllr J Noquet will ask OCC directly where Sibford Gower is in their plans to resurface roads within our Parish. The PC urges all parishioners to report all highway issues on Fix my Street.
